

DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL HEALTH CERTIFICATES

US Domestic/Mexico Travel Certificate - (Hawaii & Alaska Excluded)\$125

Must contact our office at least 1 week prior to travel.

We strongly recommend contacting your individual airline to understand their specific travel requirements. Oftentimes airlines require that your pet be examined by a veterinarian and a health certificate issued within 10 days of travel. Check with your airline to ensure that your paperwork will be in order.

International Level 1 Travel Certificate \$450

Must contact our office at least 2 weeks prior to travel.

International Level 2 Travel Certificate \$550

Must contact our office at least 1 month prior to travel.

Included Countries: Antigua and Barbuda, Algeria, Armenia, Austria, Barbados (by Air), Belarus, Belgium, Bermuda♦, British Virgin Islands☆, Bulgaria, Croatia, Curacao, Czech Republic, Denmark, Egypt, England, France, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong☆ ♦, Hungary, Iceland, India☆, Iraq, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Italy, Jamaica☆ ♦, Kenya, Kuwait, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Mali, Malta, Moldova, Morocco, Netherlands, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Norway, Philippines, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, Spain, St Maarten, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Sweden, Switzerland, Tanzania☆, Thailand☆, Turks and Caicos☆ ♦, Ukraine, Venezuela

International Level 3 Travel Certificate \$650

Must contact our office at least 3 months prior to travel. **Japan - 6 months**
Included Countries: Australia, Barbados (by sea), China, Indonesia (dogs only), Israel♦,
Japan♦, Korea, New Zealand, Singapore☆, South Africa, St Kitts and Nevis, Taiwan, Trinidad
and Tobago, Turkey, UAE

We are currently unable to provide health certificates to Hawaii, Alaska, Indonesia (cats), Liberia, Lebanon, and North Macedonia.

☆Country requires import permits registered by the owner with the arrival country.

♦Country has breed restrictions

Listed cost includes: Exam, Health Certificate, any USDA or postage.

Not included: Any required vaccinations, medication or laboratory testing.

The United States requires microchips in any animals re-entering the country from any rabies high risk territory.
